Background Context

This is the ninth quarterly mandate maintenance report produced by the Ngātiwai Trust Board (NTB) for the Office of Treaty Settlements (OTS) following the Crown's recognition of the NTB Deed of Mandate (DoM) on 21 October 2015.

The purpose of this report is to document the work undertaken by the NTB to maintain its mandate and in particular to demonstrate its ongoing commitment to continually improve its communications and engagement with Ngātiwai members so as to keep members properly informed about the negotiations and Treaty settlement journey.

Mandate Maintenance requirements

Section 55 of the Deed of Mandate states:

"The NTB will ensure that Ngātiwai members are kept regularly informed and updated on negotiations progress through:

- monthly newsletters/e-panui and website with regular updates
- hui or wananga on particular topics will be held regularly through the year
- the AGM or a Special General Meeting where the need arises (i.e. to present an iDoS and a proposal for a PSGE to the claimants community for approval and ratification)
- Negotiators will also be required to report to Te lwi o Ngātiwai on negotiations as required by the NTB (see page 22)
- monthly Board meeting summaries to be released following each meeting providing regular updates on matters under discussion by the Board and
- Three additional hui-a-iwi (in addition to the AGM) in total providing quarterly opportunities for engagement and discussion.

The focus will be on the progress of negotiations."

Section 56 of the Deed of Mandate states:

"The NTB will provide regular three monthly reports to OTS to maintain the mandate. It will include information about:

- communications with Ngātiwai (i.e.newsletters/e-panui, hui or wananga, website and Facebook updates),
- any AGMs or SGM held within the reporting period, and
- any other points of interest related to the progress of negotiations."

While it is acknowledged that the OTS have a standard form for mandate maintenance reports this report covers those requirements and builds on the previous commitments made by the Board in its Engagement and Communications Plan dated 13 December 2014. For this reason it includes a brief summary of progress made towards achieving specific objectives established in December 2014.

Issues Arising

Terms of Negotiation and Urgent Hearings

Completion of Terms of Negotiations (ToN) were paused pending the outcome of the Ngātiwai Mandate Inquiry by the Waitangi Tribunal. The Board received the Tribunal's report on 31 October 2017. The Board is yet to address the outcomes of the Tribunals report.

Overlapping Claims with other lwi / Large Natural Groupings

On 24 July 2017 the Trust Board filed an application for an urgent inquiry into the Crown's settlement policy regarding overlapping claims redress in relation to the Hauraki Collective, Marutuahu Collective and Individual Hauraki iwi settlements.

On 6 October 2017 the Crown objected to the Trust Boards application and on 6 November 2017 the Trust Board responded to the Crown's objection. The Board now await the Tribunals decision on if an urgent hearing will be granted.

Despite the Boards urgency application the Crown introduced the Ngai Tai ki Tamaki Settlement Bill into the house on 9 August 2017 which was followed by its first reading on 15 August 2017. The Maori Affairs Select Committee then called for submission on the Bill by 19 January 2018. The Board duly filed a submission in opposition to the Bill and requested to be heard at hearings on the matter.

Communications and Engagement with Ngātiwai Whanui

Open Door Policy and Face to Face Engagement Hui

Progress on this objective has been maintained.

Monthly Board Updates and Newsletters

Monthly Board meeting summaries are now regularly posted to our website and facebook pages following each Board meeting. They are also included in our newsletter which is then sent to our Kaumātua by post along with a hard copy of the newsletter.

Trust Deed Review

The Trustees have asked the review group to clarify certain matters in the report. However, the review group has suffered by loss of membership which have dwindled.

Wananga Planning for PSGE

The Board is currently considering the findings and recommendations from the Waitangi Tribunals Ngātiwai Mandate Inquiry report which includes recommendations on this matter.

Quarterly Hui-a-lwi

The AGM took take place on 25 November 2017 at Toll Stadium in Whangarei. The Annual Report was posted to our facebook page and website and made available at the AGM and at the Board's office.

Finalise the Strategic Communications Plan

The plan has been completed and is available on our website for public view.

Review, refine and maintain the current database

Regular address updates and new registrations continue to be promoted and received.

The total number of registered members as at 31 January 2018 is 7928 (including 30 pending registrations). This is an increase of 39 registered members within the quarter.

The percentage of registered members who are recorded as without a known postal address or are recorded as Gone-No-Address (GNA) is 13.5%.
