1. Applicants **must** provide proof they are currently **enrolled** in a tertiary course.
2. The applicant **must** be studying part-time or full-time.
3. The applicant is of Ngāti Wai descent and a registered beneficiary of the Ngātiwai Trust Board.
4. The applicant has correctly completed the application form.
5. The application is received by the due date.
6. The applicant accepts the decision as final with no right to an appeal
7. Selection will be based on the assessed ability of each candidate to successfully undertake and complete the agreed study.
8. Complete all sections and sign and date the application form.
9. Successful candidates will be notified within 4 weeks after the closing date.
10. Successful applicants will **not** be eligible to apply for another Scholarship of any kind from the Ngātiwai Trust Board for a minimum of 2 years.
