Background Context

This is the second quarterly mandate maintenance report produced by the Ngātiwai Trust Board (NTB) for the Office of Treaty Settlements (OTS) following the Crown's recognition of the NTB Deed of Mandate (DoM) on 21 October 2014. The purpose of this report is to document the work undertaken by the NTB to maintain its mandate and in particular to demonstrate its ongoing commitment to continually improve its communications and engagement with Ngātiwai members so as to keep them properly informed about the negotiations and Treaty settlement journey.

Mandate Maintenance requirements

Section 55 of the Deed of Mandate states:

"The NTB will ensure that Ngātiwai members are kept regularly informed and updated on negotiations progress through:

- monthly newsletters/e-panui and website with regular updates
- hui or wananga on particular topics will be held regularly through the year
- the AGM or a Special General Meeting where the need arises (i.e. to present an iDoS and a proposal for a PSGE to the claimants community for approval and ratification)
- Negotiators will also be required to report to Te Iwi o Ngātiwai on negotiations as required by the NTB (see page 22)
- monthly Board meeting summaries to be released following each meeting providing regular updates on matters under discussion by the Board and
- Three additional hui-a-iwi (in addition to the AGM) in total providing quarterly opportunities for engagement and discussion.

The focus will be on the progress of negotiations."

Section 56 of the Deed of Mandate states:

"The NTB will provide regular three monthly reports to OTS to maintain the mandate. It will include information about:

- communications with Ngātiwai (i.e.newsletters/e-panui, hui or wananga, website and facebook updates),
- any AGMs or SGM held within the reporting period, and
- any other points of interest related to the progress of negotiations."

While it is acknowledged that the OTS have a standard form for mandate maintenance reports this report covers those requirements and builds on the previous commitments made by the Board in its Engagement and Communications Plan dated 13 December 2014. For this reason it includes a brief summary of progress made towards achieving specific objectives established in December 2014.

Issues Arising

During this period the Board continued to provide evidence and affidavits in response to applications for urgent hearings up until 6 April 2016. This put considerable pressure on our people and finances. Despite that it was felt that the Board through its efforts and that of its legal counsel was able demonstrated the extensive efforts it had undertaken to achieve a robust mandate. In addition it provided the Tribunal with ample evidence to consider in relation to shared hapu and hapu cross claimants.

Points of Interest

During this period the Board:

- Considered a first full DRAFT Terms of Negotiations proposed by OTS and sought professional advice on it from the strategic, legal and research advisors.
- Considered and provided feedback on Terms of Reference for all the supporting structures set out in the Deed of Mandate (pp 20 to 22).
- Called for and received expressions of interest from members of Ngātiwai Kaumatua,
 Hapu and Marae to participate in a Negotiator interview panel.
- Prepared a recruitment process for two further negotiators to complete the Negotiations Team.

A number of overlapping claims issues have come to the attention of the Board within this period which the Board will be addressing in due course including:

- The Crown offer of cultural redress to Ngati Paoa of Te Haupa (Saddle Island) for vest and vest back.
- A request from Ngati Rehua-Ngati Wai ki Aotea to engage with the Board to discuss overlapping claims issues within its area of interest with a view to initialling a deed of settlement with the Crown in 2016.
- The Crown's ongoing negotiations with Ngati Maru and Ngati Tamatera of the Marutuahu confederation relating to redress offered on Aotea (Great Barrier Is).

Brief Summary of Progress with Specific Objectives

Engagement Objectives

- 1. **Open Door Policy and Face to Face Engagement Hui.** Progress on this objective has been maintained although at a lesser pace due to the February Waitangi Tribunal hearings week held in Whangarei and filing of urgency applications and responses. However see also report on objective 5 below.
- Monthly Board Updates and Newsletters. Progress on this objective has been maintained with monthly Board meeting summaries posted to our website and fb pages in a timely fashion for January, March and April. There was no February Board meeting. Newsletters were also posted for February, March and April 2016. There was no January newsletter.
- 3. **Trust Deed Review.** Progress on this objective has been maintained with the focus group having received its independent legal advice and a meeting recently took place to discuss the advice and next steps.
- 4. **Wananga Planning for PSGE.** Progress on this objective was made at the wananga held in February 2016 with a specific workshop topic to provide opportunity for questions, discussion and feedback to be received and considered.
- 5. **Quarterly Hui-a-lwi**. Progress on this objective was achieved with the February wananga as a substitute providing a more relaxed environment for discussion. The board received very positive feedback on the wananga from those who attended.

Communications Objectives:

- 1. **Finalise the Strategic Communications Plan**. Progress on this objective has been made with the presentation of a revised strategy presented to the Board for approval in April 2016 following feedback received at the February wananga.
- 2. **Review, refine and maintain the current database**. Progress with this objective has been made with regular address updates and new registrations being received.
- 3. Social Media Integration and 4. Recruitment of Staff have been achieved.
