Background Context

This is the forth quarterly mandate maintenance report produced by the Ngātiwai Trust Board (NTB) for the Office of Treaty Settlements (OTS) following the Crown's recognition of the NTB Deed of Mandate (DoM) on 21 October 2014.

The purpose of this report is to document the work undertaken by the NTB to maintain its mandate and in particular to demonstrate its ongoing commitment to continually improve its communications and engagement with Ngātiwai members so as to keep members properly informed about the negotiations and Treaty settlement journey.

Mandate Maintenance requirements

Section 55 of the Deed of Mandate states:

"The NTB will ensure that Ngātiwai members are kept regularly informed and updated on negotiations progress through:

- monthly newsletters/e-panui and website with regular updates
- hui or wananga on particular topics will be held regularly through the year
- the AGM or a Special General Meeting where the need arises (i.e. to present an iDoS and a proposal for a PSGE to the claimants community for approval and ratification)
- Negotiators will also be required to report to Te lwi o Ngātiwai on negotiations as required by the NTB (see page 22)
- monthly Board meeting summaries to be released following each meeting providing regular updates on matters under discussion by the Board and
- Three additional hui-a-iwi (in addition to the AGM) in total providing quarterly opportunities for engagement and discussion.

The focus will be on the progress of negotiations."

Section 56 of the Deed of Mandate states:

"The NTB will provide regular three monthly reports to OTS to maintain the mandate. It will include information about:

- communications with Ngātiwai (i.e.newsletters/e-panui, hui or wananga, website and facebook updates),
- any AGMs or SGM held within the reporting period, and
- any other points of interest related to the progress of negotiations."

While it is acknowledged that the OTS have a standard form for mandate maintenance reports this report covers those requirements and builds on the previous commitments made by the Board in its Engagement and Communications Plan dated 13 December 2014. For this reason it includes a brief summary of progress made towards achieving specific objectives established in December 2014.

Ngatiwai Trust Board Quarterly Report: 1 August – 31 October 2016

1. Terms of Negotiation and Urgent Hearings

- On 21 October 2015 NTB received Crown recognition of its mandate and commenced discussions on Terms of Negotiation (ToN) – see previous reports.
- In December 2016 March 2017 eleven applications for urgent hearings into the Crowns recognition of the mandate were lodged with the Waitangi Tribunal and on 2 May 2016 the Tribunal granted urgent hearings. Initial hearings were held on 4, 5 and 6 October 2016 with two additional days set down for 1 and 2 December to be held in Wellington at the Tribunal office.
- When the Tribunal granted hearings the Board paused the process to populate any further supporting structures in the mandate. However discussion on all supporting structures will continue in the meantime and be reviewed following the outcome of the inquiry.

2. Overlapping Claims with other lwi or LNG's

- The Board have continued engagement with Ngati Rehua Ngati Wai ki Aotea (and OTS) concerning their settlement and have provided a number of written responses in this regard. Discussions are ongoing with a Deed of Settlement expected to be signed within 2016. A proposal for a PSGE is also expected to be put to members to consider and ratify.
- The Board continued to inquire into the circumstances surrounding the Crown's engagement process and offers of redress to individual iwi and Marutūahu collective. The Board have provided written responses to Crown proposals for redress to these lwi on Aotea. Hui with iwi concerned to discuss overlapping claims are yet to be confirmed.

3. Communications and Engagement with Ngatiwai Whanui

- 1. Open Door Policy and Face to Face Engagement Hui. Progress on this objective has been maintained despite the diversion of focused effort to the Ngatiwai Mandate Inquiry and work on overlapping claims (as outlined above).
- 2. Monthly Board Updates and Newsletters. Newsletters were produced in August and a combined September/October newsletter containing monthly Board meeting summaries. Note the September Board meeting was held in-committee and as a result there is no summary. These newsletters/summaries were also posted to our facebook page and mailed to Kaumātua on our distribution list.
- **3. Trust Deed Review**. The review group continue to work through issues with a new issue identified for further consideration at the September hui a iwi.
- **4. Wananga Planning for PSGE**. Some feedback has been received on representative models at and following the September 2016 wananga. At this point the wananga is to be held in 2017 following the conclusion of the Ngatiwai Mandate Inquiry.
- 5. Quarterly Hui-a-lwi. A hui-a-iwi was held at Ngunguru Marae on 9 and 10 September 2016. Discussions or presentations took place on PSGE considerations including representative options. Research was discussed and there was an opportunity for engagement with the board on a wide range of member interests. Board unit quarterly reports were also provided at the hui.
- 6. Finalise the Strategic Communications Plan. The plan has been completed and is available on our website for public view.
- 7. Review, refine and maintain the current database. Regular address updates and new registrations continue to be promoted and received.
