- 1. Applicants **must** provide proof they are currently **enrolled** in a tertiary course.
- 2. The applicant **must** be studying part-time or full-time.
- 3. The applicant is of Ngāti Wai descent and a registered beneficiary of the Ngātiwai Trust Board.
- 4. The applicant has correctly completed the application form.
- 5. The application is received by the due date.
- 6. The applicant accepts the decision as final with no right to an appeal
- 7. Selection will be based on the assessed ability of each candidate to successfully undertake and complete the agreed study.
- 8. Complete all sections and sign and date the application form.
- 9. Successful candidates will be notified within 4 weeks after the closing date.
- 10. Successful applicants will **not** be eligible to apply for another Scholarship of any kind from the Ngātiwai Trust Board for a minimum of 2 years.
